### NEW PERIOD OF CO-OPERATION

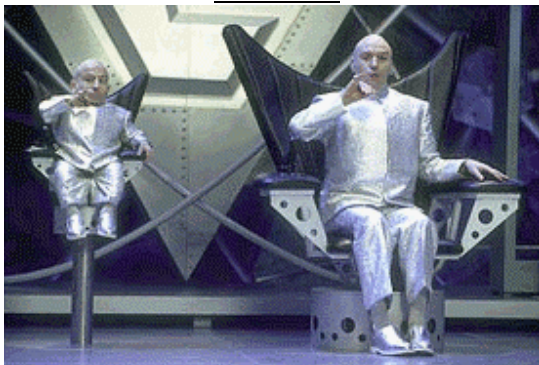
Management have requested that we enter into a period of driver/management co-operation which will necessitate a bit of give and take. This will take the form shown below.

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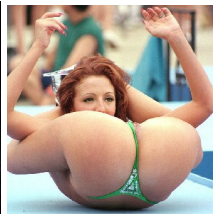
## MIRTLE TALKS BACK

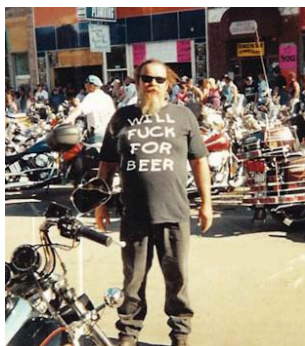

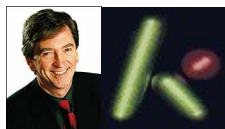
